OTHER SOURCES FOR FUNDING

- Calls for tenders and Calls for proposals from the Commission
- Specific procurement pages at each DG or TED (Tenders Electronic Daily)
- Advantages:
 - Become familiar with EU discourses and thinking
 - Test your skills in writing and budgeting proposals
 - Sometimes quite applied and concrete research
 - Not as extensive proposals as H2020

- EU Programme for Employment and Social Innovation (EaSI)
- PROGRESS axis of EaSI; social protection; 61% of total budget
- total budget for 2014-2020 is EUR 919,469,000 in 2013 prices

DG SANTE

- Third Health Program
- Calls more focused on curative health and diseases; sometimes also on prevention/life styles
- Promote health, prevent diseases and foster supportive environments for healthy lifestyles
- 2014-2020, budget: 449,4 million EUR
- Executive Agency is CHAFEA

COST is supported by the
EU Framework Programme Horizon 2020

- COST
- EU-funded programme enables researchers to set up their interdisciplinary research networks in Europe and beyond
- provides funds for organising conferences, meetings, training schools, short scientific exchanges or other networking activities in a wide range of scientific topics
- Interesting to combine with running network activities or exchange; or to prepare for future project proposals
- e.g. COST Action IS1409 Gender and health impacts of policies extending working life in Western countries (Karlstad University from Sweden is a member)

JPI MORE YEARS, BETTER LIVES

- MYBL
- Every year a specific call; last call was on ‘Ageing and place in a digitising world’
- Only available for applicants from countries that collaborate in the JPI
