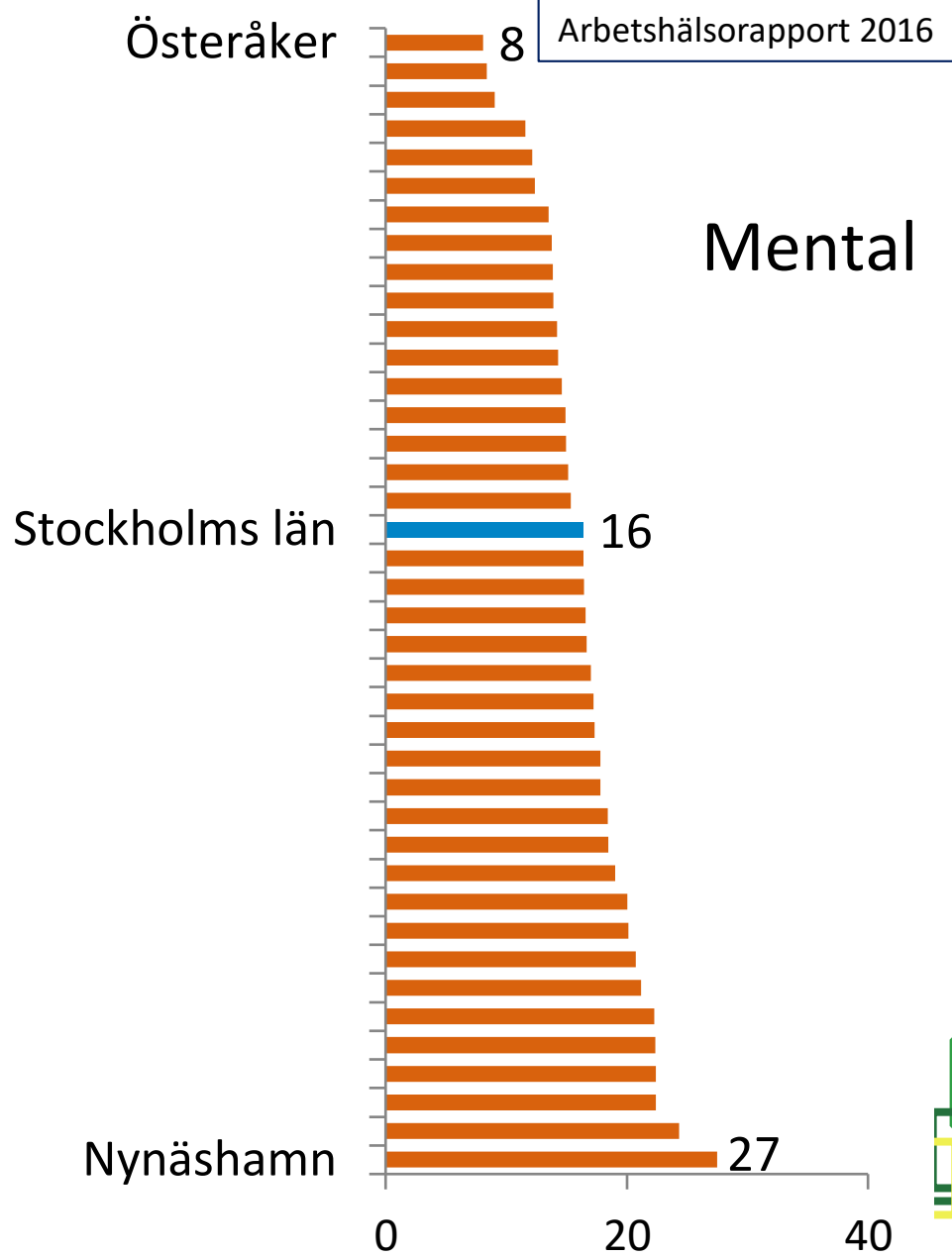
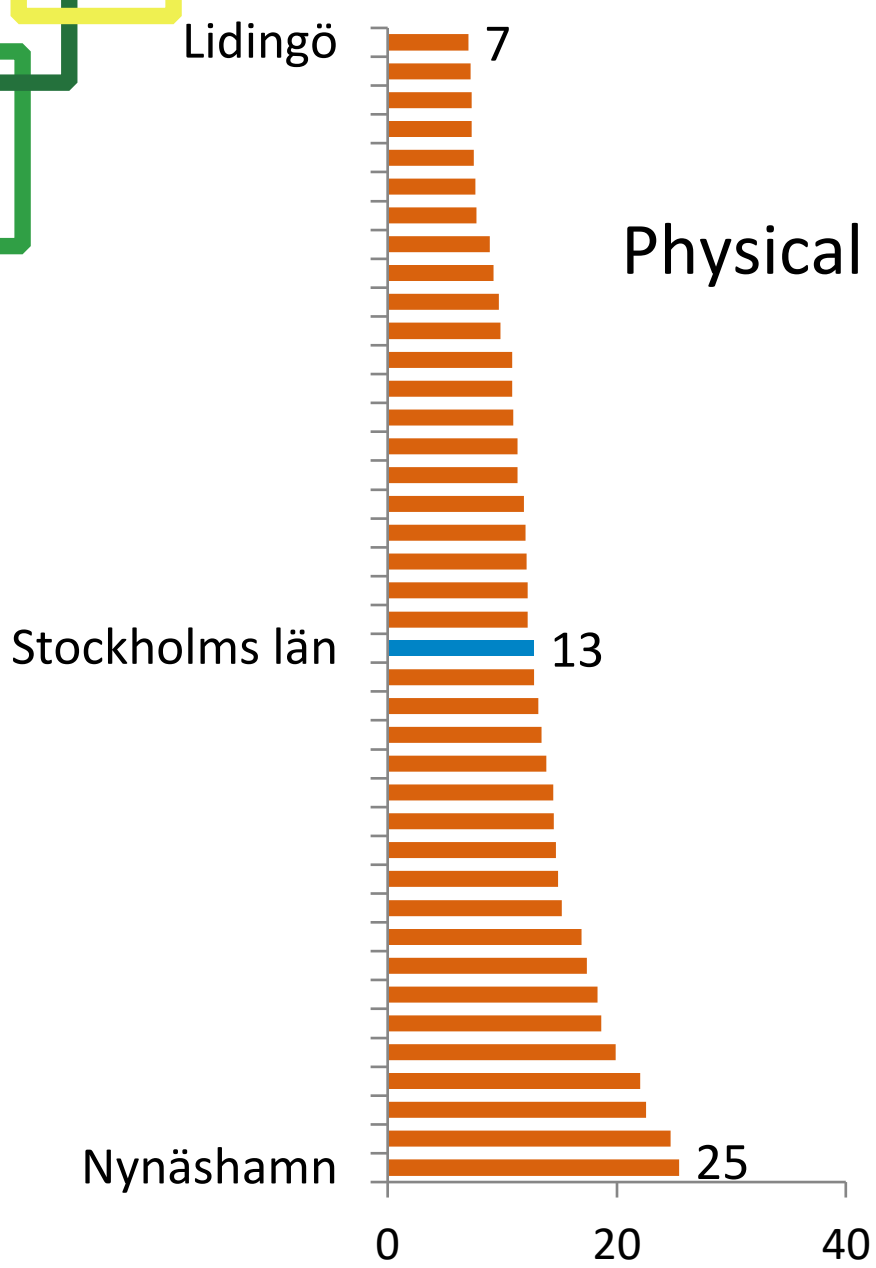

Rationale

Work is an essential part of most adults life – the quality of life of 241 million European workers and their families



Research

- "Europe at work" poorly visible in Horizon2020 – in spite of focus on Societal challenges and Industrial Leadership
 - Applies also to former FPs
- Shrinking national funding – Horizon 2020 has €80 billion
- Worklife research is highly competitive in e.g Scandinavia
 - Strong tradition
 - Excellent infrastructure (registers, workplace access)

Key for grand challenges

- Globalisation
 - Productivity, innovation-based growth,
- Demographic shifts
 - Ageing, shrinking workforce
 - Migration
- Social inclusion
 - Increasing diversity in work, health and wellbeing

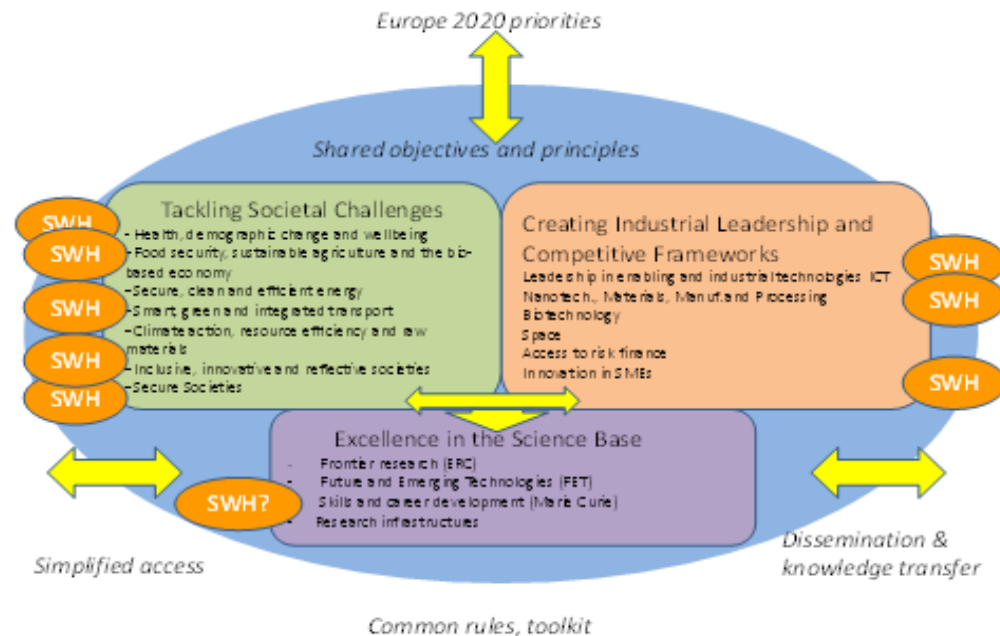


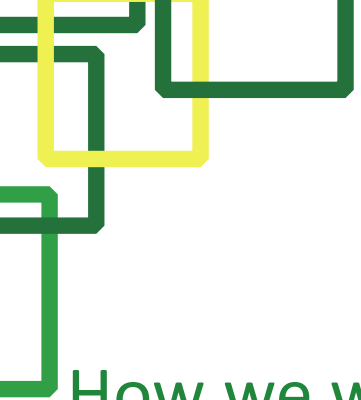
Priority: Sustainable management of an ageing workforce

Figure 6. EWIN - the European Workplace Innovation Network

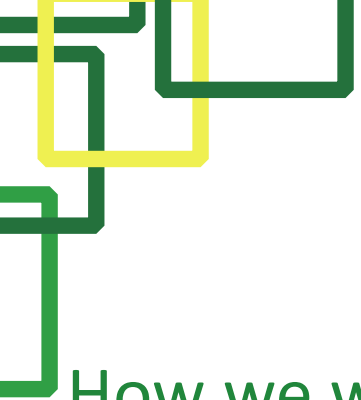

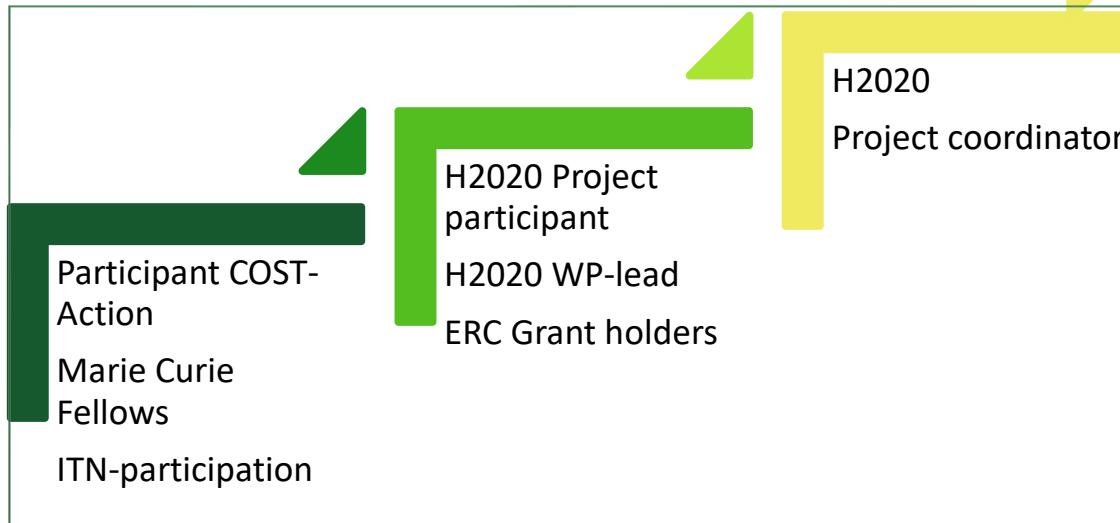
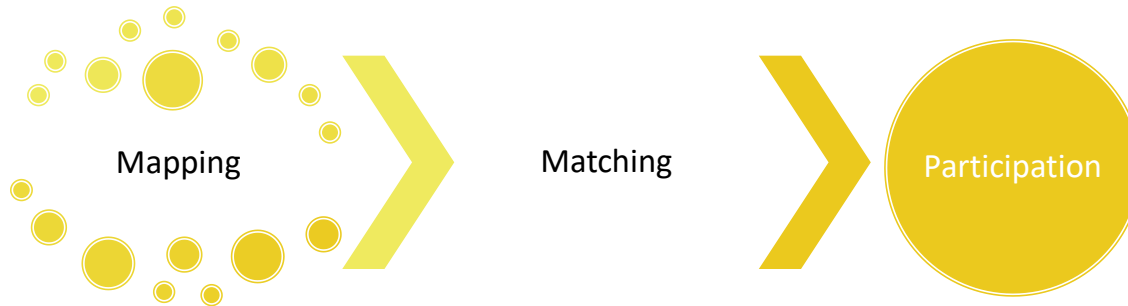
